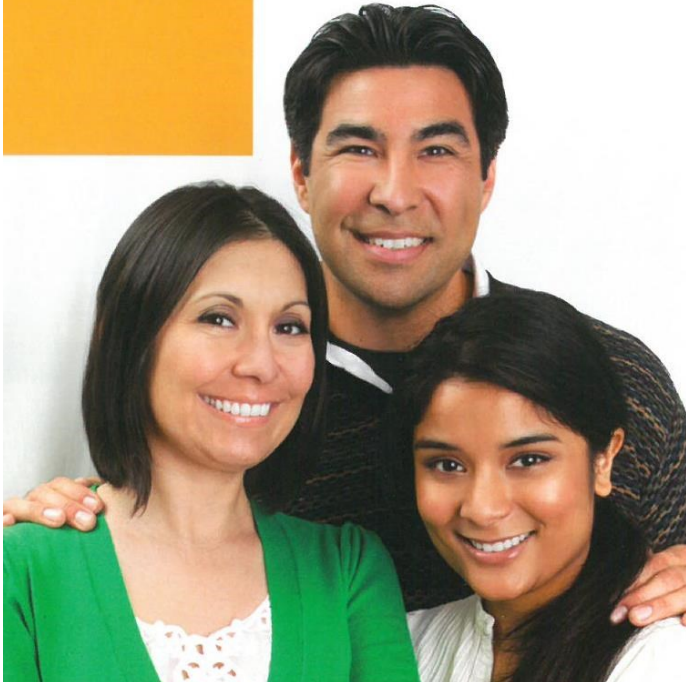


Family-to-Family
